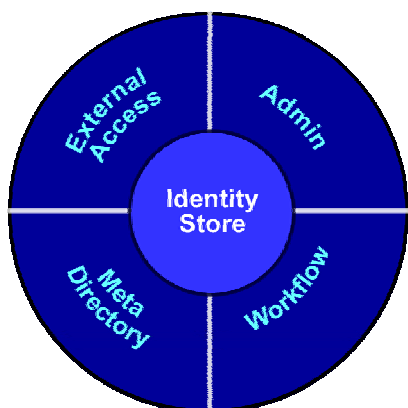
System Architecture

The MaXware Identity Center is designed to provide maximum flexibility, scalability and security – allowing management across multiple applications and repositories. MIC's provisioning, workflow, password management, reconciliation, user self-service and meta-directory functionality is delivered in a single vendor-neutral software solution.

MIC Identity Store

MIC revolves around the Identity Store, the central store for all identity data.

All information about provisioning/workflow tasks and jobs, scheduling information and audit/logs is kept in this passive store.



Provisioning and Workflow

Provisioning is the process of automatically executing preconfigured tasks in a specified order. Workflow is the process of breaking down the business operations into provisioning tasks. MIC enables organizations to design automated workflows in accordance with company policies and procedures. MIC's intelligent rules engine provides full control over the updating and synchronizing of identity information.

User Self-Service

MIC's user friendly web-based interface allows end users to manage their own profiles and accounts as well as to request entitlements, permissions and resources.

MIC's powerful password management feature allows users to reset passwords and synchronize them across applications, reducing the number of Help Desk calls and the burden on administrators.

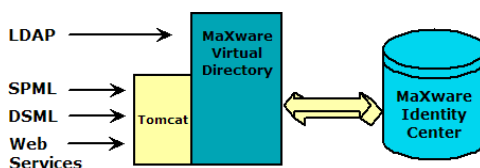
Auditing and Reporting
