These include the latest versions of Mac OS X Leopard, VMware ESX, IBM AIX and the latest releases from Linux distributors. This wide platform support allows enterprises to select the optimal platform to support their application requirements with the confidence that authentication and access control can be administered centrally and economically from Microsoft Active Directory.

Version 4.1 also enhances Centrify DirectControl's support for web and Java-based applications by adding clustering support, additional platform coverage and extended cross-forest support (including one-way trust). As a result, organizations can depend on enterprise-quality authentication, authorization and federation support for scalable, high-availability Java applications that are deployed in a clustered configuration.

New system support added with DirectControl 4.1 includes: Mac OS X Leopard 10.5.2; OpenSuSE 10.3; Red Hat Enterprise Linux (RHEL) 3 for PowerPC; RHEL 4 for Itanium; RHEL 5.1, RHEL Desktop 5.1; Red Hat Fedora 8; Scientific Linux 4.5; Ubuntu Desktop/Server LTS 6.06 / 7.04 / 7.10; IBM AIX 6.1 and VMware ESX 3.5. With Centrify DirectControl, organizations with diverse IT environments can leverage their investment in Active Directory to move to a central directory with a single point of administration for user accounts and security policy.
